Background

Glenveagh are committed to improving resource efficiency by reducing material use and waste disposal. This forms an important part of the Groups approach to sustainability and its aim to be a responsible housebuilder/developer. An efficient business will be a profitable one, and one better able to reduce the life cycle impacts of materials, wastes, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to climate change.

Our waste and resource management policy, takes account of our requirement to minimise resource use and divert materials from landfill, thereby reducing waste, and the cost of waste management and ensuring compliance with all legal and other requirements.

Our Approach

Our approach to resource management is based on good business practice and the following hierarchy:

- Minimising the use of material resources and the production of waste through, for example, efficient design, logistics, stock control, the use of prefabricated/pre-sized materials, minimising packaging and efficient construction techniques.
- Maximisation of on-site recovery (reuse and recycling or treatment)
- Careful consideration of the options when there are materials surplus to a site’s needs or a materials shortfall
- Minimisation of disposal of waste to landfill

We measure, monitor and report annually on progress on resource efficiency, and are committed to continual improvement in resource management. We are committed to compliance with legislation and industry standards as a minimum including Site Waste Management Plans that we produce for all are developments. We have set up a responsibility agreement with our suppliers that communicates our priorities and seeks to increase resource efficiency in the supply chain by reducing waste through design, good site practice and minimisation of packaging materials. We will continue to train or inform our employees, contractors and suppliers about waste management and resource efficiency issues.

Roles and Responsibilities

Our policy is regularly reviewed by our Group’s Executive Committee reflecting the company’s commitment to Customer Service. It is shared with employees, stakeholders, business partners and is readily available on our website.

The Group’s activities related to climate change are reviewed on a regular basis by the Sustainability Committee and supported by the development of objectives and targets for the business when appropriate.
